Welcome to the beginning of the 2025 season on the lake! As some of you may know, Shavehead Lake has two lake associations. This membership letter is being distributed by the Shavehead Lake Association (SLA). SLA uses dues to fund items related to lake health, boating safety, water quality, community outreach, the Michigan Riparian Magazine, and social events mentioned in this "Membership Letter". The Shavehead Lake Peninsula Association (SLPA) was formed to address land issues relating to peninsula owners, such as security concerns and select peninsula social events. If you live on the peninsula, it is beneficial to belong to both associations as the concentrations are different.

Our SLA meetings will be held on the second Saturday of each month beginning in May and ending in September. Everyone is welcome to attend!

Music on the Lake was enjoyed by many last year and will continue this year. Of the monies collected in this fund, \$750 will be issued to each of the bands performing as partial payment for their performance. The hosts will make up the difference. If you are a music lover, dancer, or someone who loves having a good time, consider donating to this fund or volunteering to be a host.

The fireworks show will be set off at dusk on the evening of Saturday, July 5th from the northeast shore of Camp Friedenswald. **Thank you** to the Camp for agreeing to the use of their property for this much-loved event. **Thank you** to Porter Township Fire Department who are always watching over the lighting of the fireworks. We are starting the 2025 fireworks fund with a healthy fund carryover because of an abundance of late donations last year. The more we have in the fund, the more fireworks we can purchase for the show. Please send your fireworks' donations in as early as you can. **Thank you** to all for the generous

donations to the fireworks fund. Along with paying for the show, SLA also donates to the Porter Township Fire Department and the extensive cleanup on Camp Friedenswald property.

We have **Automatic Emergency Defibrillators (AEDs)** placed around the lake. Five units, which are both adult and pediatric compatible, have been installed at the following locations: on the East side the Landis residence (roadside on Lakeview Drive), on the West side the Mark/Harder residence (roadside North Drive), and on the South side the Hendricks' boathouse (lakeside), at Camp Friedenswald's beach (East side) and on the peninsula at the Fish residence (pole barn/back lot East Peninsula Drive). A map of the lake is enclosed with the locations marked.

Water quality -- We will be working with Kieser & Associates to test the water quality this year. The water quality report received for 2024 indicated a concerning increase in phosphorus which can cause serious problems with water quality, clarity and decreased oxygen levels if the trends continue. The SLA is investigating additional water quality testing which will help to pinpoint the source of the increase in phosphorus. We have also applied for a grant through Ecosystems Connections Institute (ECI) for extensive water quality testing at multiple water inlets. A big **thank you** to the volunteers who will be routinely collecting the water samples.

We invite you to attend the SLA meetings to learn more about what the SLA is doing or to get involved in planning or volunteering for any of the events.
